GENERAL PARADE RULES

- 1. To be part of the Clermont 175th Parade an official application must be submitted. The Clermont 175th Committee will decide on all parade entries as to whether they are appropriate to be in the parade.
- 2. Individuals/organizations must agree to all parade rules and guidelines herein. Your acceptance of the rules in the parade application serves as a waiver of liability and an indemnification agreement between all participants in your contingent and the City of Clermont. It also serves as your agreement to make all participants in your contingent aware of all the rules and guidelines.
- 3. Line-up starts at 9:00 am. The parade starts promptly at 10:30.
- 4. Horses or horse-drawn vehicles must receive permission in advance of the event from the committee. Must also supply your own means to follow your horses and clean up after them on the route.
- 5. All vehicles in the parade are required to be in good operating condition and be legal for the road. All vehicles must be able to navigate the entire parade route and make all turns required without difficulty (please keep in mind the width of our city streets).
- 6. Any individuals who operate a truck, car, tractor, or any other type of vehicle in the parade must possess a valid driver's license and proper insurance.
- 7. All participants are expected to abide by general behavior guidelines.
- 8. The Clermont 175th Committee does not endorse the views, representations, and behaviors of parade participants
